Are you a bit confused by how to do a shelf search, and how to find books in different call number ranges? Here's a demonstration:

Using the example of Leonardo da Vinci, you can find all sorts of things if you simply do a Sojourner Truth catalog search for "Leonardo da Vinci" and then patiently go through all of the results.

- You'll find TONS of books in the N range: N, NA, NB, NC, ND, etc.
- It's OK to have more than one target book in the N range, so long as they're spaced far enough apart, such as one call number starting with N, and another with ND.

But what about the other call number ranges? Consider Leonardo from different angles! The screen shots below are a result of my doing Sojourner Truth Library searches for:

- Leonardo da Vinci
- Italian Renaissance history
- Italian Renaissance culture
- Italian Renaissance painting technique
- Renaissance philosophy

If you look at the call numbers in the screen shots below you'll see books in these call number ranges (or classes): A, B, C, D, N, P, Q, T, R, and U.
