



New Paltz is located approximately 90 miles north of New York City, just off the New York State Thruway (Interstate 87), in the Hudson River valley. The closest major airports are Newburgh (approximately 20 minutes from New Paltz) and Albany (about 1 ½ hrs). New York City airports are approximately 2 hours away. There are buses from NYC Port Authority that go directly to New Paltz.

If you're driving, you will need to eventually get on Interstate 87, the New York State Thruway, which runs North-South from New York City to Albany. New Paltz is Exit 18.

There are several hotels in the area. Unfortunately, Fall is the big tourist season in the Hudson Valley, when all the New York City people drive up to look at the fall foliage. So, if you're planning on staying somewhere, I suggest you make your reservations as soon as possible—before all the tourists take them all.
